Which also happens to be, coincidentally, the geographical area mentioned in the poem *Davanti San Guido* by the Tuscan poet Giosué Carducci – some lines of which were quoted in April's newsletter.

The wine, experts say, "...is deep ruby with purple hues. On the nose, the wine is delicate with notes of cherry, vanilla, raw beef and herbs. On the palate, it is dry, structured and elegant with flavors of plum, ripe cherries, wild berries and a hint of spice, followed by a lengthy and smooth finish that begs for food." Couldn't have said it better myself...



Worth mentioning, I think, Piazza Italia's excellent lasagnas, with pasta al pesto as a side dish, which also pleased the non-vegetarians. And the equally excellent cake, of whose selection, Audrey gets the merit. The music by the Dennis Costi Combo (also Audrey's idea) added another good touch.
